NRCS State Resource Conservationist Elise Boeke has accepted a 6-month detail with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in Denver, where she will provide support to the Blackfooted Ferret Recovery Program through the development of a Safe Harbor Agreement (SHA). The SHA will be applicable to private landowners throughout the range of the ferret and will provide regulatory assurances for to farmers and ranchers for their customary agricultural practices. She will be leaving for her detail tomorrow (See accompanying photo).

Danny McBride, Area I Resource Conservationist for NRCS in the Ogden Area Office, will be acting State Resource Conservationist for the next two months, starting January 16.
